**Be it Resolved and Enacted, and it is hereby resolved and enacted** by the Board of Supervisors of the Township of West Bradford, Chester County, Pennsylvania.


**Whereas**, the Board of Supervisors have adopted Ordinance 99-04; wherein it is prescribed that an annual fee shall be set by resolution for fire hydrant protection for properties benefiting from fire hydrants;

**Whereas**, the Board of Supervisors have determined that the fee for 2001, and continuing yearly thereafter until reassessed, shall be twenty-four (\$24.00) dollars per tax parcel served;






